3. Alan and Mary Ellen Burris – 7 East Jefferson Circle – Siding and Replacement Windows

Present: Mr. & Mrs. Burris

Application: Submitted, date stamped, and building inspector approved 6/21/01.

Discussion: The owners are proposing to install (Alside) vinyl siding and vinyl replacement slider windows for their 1954 post war home (county record) to remedy energy problems. Existing siding is cedar with board and baton on the garage. Existing windows are wood. One group of windows on the front of the home is 93”W with 9 panes; the other group is 61”W with 6 panes. Each pane has its own storm window. The Board reviewed the information presented in the application (Alside, CertainTeed, Crane Performance Siding, Alcoa Building Products) along with Preservation Brief #8, Planning & Zoning Appeal, five questions presented by the Planning and Zoning Board, Bero Report, Secretary of Interior Standards, and the Village Code of Pittsford. This information was carefully reviewed and fully discussed by the Board.

Motion: Chairperson Held made a motion, seconded by Member Pierson, to deny the application as submitted for vinyl siding and replacement windows. This decision is based on the careful review of all submitted materials associated with this application. Other information considered included the county record of the home built in 1954, the Village of Pittsford being a Historic & Architectural Design District, the Code of Village of Pittsford governing the APRB, the Federal Secretary of Interior Standards, Bero Report, Preservation Brief #8, and the appeal to the Planning and Zoning Board.
