

**PROCEEDINGS OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
September 26, 2008**

Deputy Mayor Galli called the meeting to order at 7:00 AM.

The purpose of the meeting was to look at the curb cuts leading into four driveway areas from Schoen Place into property owned by Roger Powers. Mr. Powers said he is concerned that the openings for each of the driveway areas are not wide enough to accommodate trucks that will need to enter or exit the driveways.

The first driveway gives access to parking on the RG&E right of way. Mr. Powers plans to install a sidewalk along the driveway that leads to the parking area and to his property. He requests that the access be made wider so that vehicles going west on Schoen Place can make a right hand turn into this driveway. Superintendent Cufari said it was his understanding that the driveway would be an exit only. Mr. Powers disagreed. He stated he would not have access to three acres of his land if this driveway was an exit only.

The second driveway is located by the weigh station. Mr. Powers said trucks proceeding west on Schoen Place will not be able to turn right into the weigh station. He asked why the openings couldn't be made wider.

The third driveway leads to the T-shirt shop located in one of the Powers' barns. Mr. Powers said this driveway is a main thoroughfare and the entrance should be made wider. He said trucks can't turn into it without going into the other lane.

The last curb cut is for one-lane service near Wahl's Microcreamery. Mr. Powers said vehicles can't make the turn without jumping a curb.

Board members thanked Mr. Powers and said they would discuss these issues.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 AM.
