CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Corby called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM.

CONTINUATION OF A PUBLIC HEARING – BIKRAM YOGA SPECIAL PERMIT

The meeting is a continuation of a public hearing that was opened on September 13, 2011 to consider an application for the operation of a small juice bar within an existing yoga studio, located at One Grove Street.

Applicant Aaron Fleischer presented his plan to the PZBA on 9/26/11. As a result, the Village Board received written comments from Remegia Mitchell, PZBA Chairperson, regarding the Special Permit. Ms. Mitchell's memo stated that the PZBA had no issues regarding this application. She noted that Skip Bailey reported that no issues have been reported to him regarding the operation of the yoga business.

There being no one further wishing to speak for or against the special permit application, a **motion** was made by **Mayor Corby, seconded by Trustee Boehlert**, to close the public hearing.
Vote: Corby – yes, Boehlert – yes, Galli – yes. **Motion carried.**

A **motion** was made by **Mayor Corby, seconded by Trustee Galli**, to approve this application made by Aaron Fleischer of Bikram Yoga, for a special permit to operate a small juice bar within his existing yoga business at One Grove Street. Mayor Corby noted that the application is in conformance with § 210-74 B. (3) (a)-(h) of the Village Code and that the PZBA had no concerns with this application.

POSITIVELY PINK IN PITTSFORD BREAST CANCER WALK SIGN REQUEST

The Village Board received a request for sandwich board signs to advertise a walk to benefit breast cancer research which will be held in the village on October 9th. A **motion** was made by **Mayor Corby, seconded by Trustee Galli** to approve the request as follows:

- One sign may be placed on the SE corner (Phoenix Bldg.) of the Four Corners.
- One sign may be placed on the SW corner of the Jefferson Road/South Main Street intersection.
- Per §168-12 (A) (2) of the Village Code, the signs may be placed on October 2nd and removed no later than October 11th.

CANCER SERVICES PROGRAM “PAINT THE VILLAGE PINK”

Board members received a request for feedback on suggestions that were made for ways to advertise a cancer awareness event that will take place in the village during the month of October. Following discussion, a **motion** was made by **Trustee Boehlert, seconded by Mayor Corby**, to permit the following means of advertisement:

- A press conference/ribbon cutting could be held at Remembrance Park or at the east pavilion on Schoen Place on October 15th.

- Pink carnations could be handed out at the ribbon cutting or at Embrasse Moi.
